

HENRY VIGNAUD DIES

Was Secretary of Confederate Commission to Paris.

Paris, Sept. 17.—The death of Henry Vignaud, honorary counselor of the American embassy and a dean of the diplomatic corps, is announced by The Herald this morning.

Henry Vignaud was born in New Orleans in 1840. He served as a captain in the Sixty Louisiana regiment of the Confederate army in the Confederate war. He was secretary of the Confederate diplomatic commission sent to Paris in 1869. He became first secretary of the American legation in Paris in 1882, a post he retained until 1900, when he became honorary counselor.
