

NEW ORLEANS, Oct. 30.—Fire.—Last night, about 8 o'clock, a fire broke out in the store of a house situated on the corner of the Basin and Canal Carondelet, belonging to the Orleans Navigation Company, and was occupied by Mr. Rannay, engineer. The store contained wheels and other apparatus for the rail road on Bayou St. John, belonging to the navigation company. The house occupied by Mr. Rannay has been slightly injured. The store of the navigation company, and other adjacent buildings, have been destroyed. The amount of the loss is estimated at about \$800. The materials in the store have been saved.—*Bee.*
